

2015-2016 - Old Arizona Brass Band Concerts at Ft. Lowell Museum

The Old Arizona Brass Band, Performing as the 4th US Cavalry Regimental Band at Ft. Lowell, will be performing free concerts of “Music from the Western Frontier”. This will be a very entertaining, narrated, program of authentic music from the Civil War period through the late 1800’s, performed by the 20-piece period brass band, whose uniforms and instruments are authentic to the period they represent.
